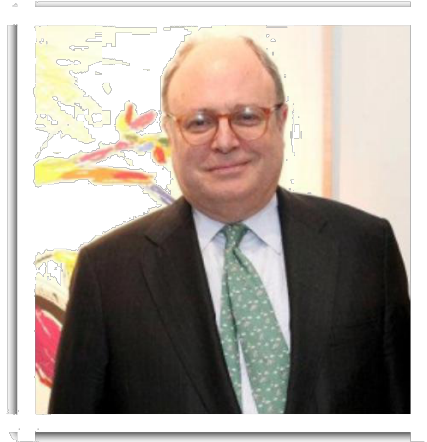




Trustee Biography
